- **Tech Square** – opened in 2003, the 1.4 M SQ FT Georgia Tech-sponsored project encompasses education, research, hospitality and retail and provides proximity to the Tech campus and resources. Tech Square serves as a new urban ‘main street’ for the campus and the Midtown Atlanta community
- Four MARTA stops and a quick train ride to the busiest airport in the world
- A major global crossroads for fiber connections
- International home to consular offices of Canada, Israel, Denmark and Switzerland; the Taipei economic/cultural office, and German American Chamber of Commerce

- **The Co-op** – An Open-source real estate cooperative for startups

- **Atlantic Station** – offers flexible “tech incubator suites” with movable walls and partitions, allowing tenants to set up spaces as they see fit.
